

# Snowmobile Poker Run

*In support of the Carleton Place & District Memorial Hospital Foundation*

## RULES FOR PLAY

### GENERAL

- ♠ Registration is located at the Beckwith Fire Hall at 1654 9<sup>th</sup> Line in Beckwith from 8 am - 10 am
- ♠ The game is stud poker. There will be no wild cards and no exchanging of cards once drawn.
- ♠ An Ace is high but may be used to form an Ace to five straight.
- ♠ Dealers shall be available to deal hands at lunch and all participants must be dealt a poker hand prior to leaving the lunch venue.
- ♠ Winners will be notified after all participants have been dealt their poker hand.
- ♠ Participants may also arrive at the lunch venue by automobile to receive their lunch and poker hand. The registration fee of \$50 will still be applicable.

### GRAND PRIZE DRAW

The drawing of hands for the grand prize draw (A NEW SNOWMOBILE from *EITHER Carleton Place Marine or Blacks Corners Motor Sports or George's Marine & Sports*) will be a separate draw from all other prizes. The cards for this draw shall be selected from a box containing 1 brand new, standard, 52 card deck. The box is to be designed so that the cards are not visible before drawing.

Participants will draw one card at a time (up to five cards) and if at anytime have drawn a card that cannot be used to form an ace high straight flush aka ðROYAL FLUSHö then that participant's turn is complete. For example:

- ♠ Participant ðAö draws his first card and it is the 8 of spades. That participant's turn is complete as that card can in no way be used to form a royal flush.
- ♠ Participant ðBö draws her first card and it is the Ace of Hearts, her second card is the Jack of Hearts, her third card is the Queen of Clubs. Participant B's turn is then complete as the third card negates the possibility of completing the royal flush.

All cards drawn are then returned to the box, the box shaken and prepared for the next participant. All draws for the grand prize will be videotaped for verification.

### PRIZES FOR BEST POKER HAND

The awarding of the prizes for the top three (3) poker hands will be governed by the following rules:

- ♠ Players shall draw 5 (five) cards from a standard 52 card deck and these cards will be recorded by the dealer.
- ♠ The dealer shall then verify if bonus cards are to be awarded and if so the player shall now draw these cards with the dealer recording them.
- ♠ Bonus cards are added to the first five drawn and the best five card poker hand is generated from all of the player's cards.
  - ♣ **Two (2) bonus cards** will be awarded for **registering and prepaying** with the CPDMH Foundation on or before Friday, February 3, 2012 at 12:00 p.m.
- ♠ After all hands are drawn and recorded, prizes will be awarded in the following manner:
  - ♣ **\$250.00 (two hundred fifty dollars)** for the participant with the *best poker hand*
  - ♣ **\$150.00 (one hundred fifty dollars)** for the participant with the *second best poker hand*
  - ♣ **\$100.00 (one hundred dollars)** for the participant with the *third best poker hand*

### TIES

In the event of a tie between poker hands, the winner shall be determined in the following manner:

- ♠ Tied players will each draw one card from the deck, high card wins; (Ace is high.). The drawing of one card from the deck by tied players will continue until a winner emerges. There **will not** be a suit preference.
