This was in recognition of its incredible fundraising efforts to buy equipment to set up an orthopaedic arthroscopy program in the hospital. Flora continues to be a dedicated and very active member of our organization.

The CPDMH Auxiliary currently has 114 members, who donate about 20,000 hours of service a year and who have pledged to raise \$1, 000,000 through fundraising to support our local hospital.
