Reporting to the Integrated Director, Allied Health, the incumbent is responsible for performing all aspects of the management of Clinical Nutrition, direct nutrition assessment and counselling to both in-patients and out-patients referred from physicians in the Hospital's catchment area, and provides clinical education and training to staff, community caregivers and families in adapting diets and menus to medical conditions. *All temporary assignments can be cancelled following the language of the collective agreement.*

- Current member with the College of Dietitians of Ontario
- Certified Diabetes Educator (CDE)
- Minimum two years practical and related experience
- Completion of a supervised internship through an integrated undergrad program or post-degree
- Experienced in educating groups and precepting dietetic interns or supervising students as required
- Ability to assess and direct appropriate programs to meet the needs of patients
- Demonstrated managerial skills of planning, co-ordinating, implementing and evaluating to ensure that hospital systems contribute to quality patient care
- Ability to function in an independent, self-directed manner or as part of a multi-disciplinary team
- Flexibility and ability to prioritize and deal with changes in tasks with short notice
- Experienced with medical software for charting and booking patients, preferably Meditech
- Proficient in software applications including use of data bases, web based tools, word, excel, PowerPoint and other relevant work-related technologies
- Strong interpersonal skills with ability to communicate effectively in both oral and written format
